HYDRO INVESTMENT PROJECTS FINALISES RENOVATION OF SMALL HYDRO PLANT IN SIELEN, GERMANY

Amsterdam, July 1, 2010

Hydro Investment Projects B.V. (HIP) announced today that it has completed the renovation of the small hydro plant on the river Diemel in the Hessen town of Kirchzarten, Germany. The plant has been in operation in its current set up since 1954.

The plant was acquired in 2009 and completely renovated in the last 12 months. Besides all necessary technical improvements, HIP has given much care to the ecological improvements. Besides a well-functioning fish ladder, the plant has been provided with a specially round-formed 15mm trash rack, which is exceptional for the industry. Furthermore HIP has created an extra fish ladder in the river on a location that has no relation to the hydro plant, in order for the fish to migrate even further.

Also the water volume that is not being used for the turbines (rest water) has been increased in order to improve the fauna.
